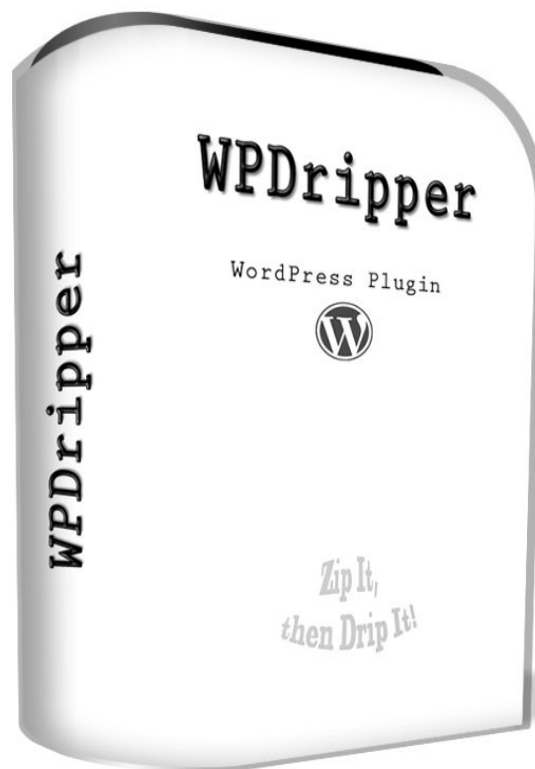


WPDripper

WordPress Plugin



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Installation

This plugin has been tested for compatibility with Wordpress Versions 2.7 & 2.8 (Up until latest 2.8.5)

The WP Dripper Wordpress plugin installs like every other Wordpress plugin.

There are 2 different methods to install a new plugin on Wordpress:

A. Manual Plugin Installation

Upload:

- Unzip the zipfile you received on your local hard drive
- Upload the WPDripper.php file to the wp-content/plugins folder in your WordPress directory.

Activate the Plugin:

- Select "Installed" on the Plugin Panel in your WordPress Administration Panels
- Scroll down through the list of Plugins to find the newly installed Plugin (if not visible, start from the beginning to check to see if you followed the instructions properly and uploaded the file correctly).
- Click on the "Activate" link to turn the Plugin on.

B. From Within WordPress

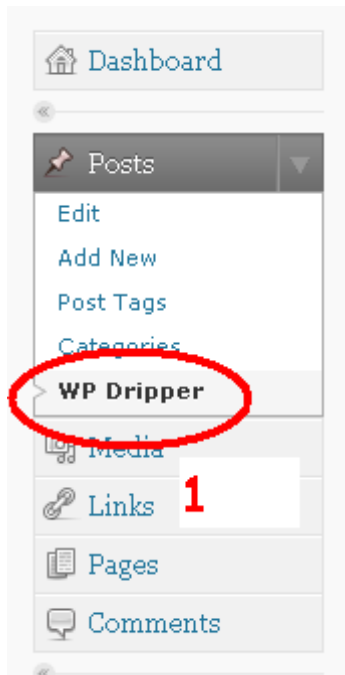

- Access the Plugin Panel in your WordPress Administration Panels
- Select “Add New” (1)
- Select “Upload” (2)
- Select “Choose” (3) then browse to where your zipfile containing the plugin is located

- Select the plugin installation zipfile (4)
- Click “Open” to use the zipfile (5)
- Select “Install Now” (6) to install the plugin
- Select “Installed” on the Plugin Panel in your WordPress Administration Panels
- Scroll down through the list of Plugins to find the newly installed Plugin
- Click on the “Activate” link to turn the Plugin on.

How To Access WP Dripper

A. Access the WP Dripper settings form by selecting “WPDripper” on the Posts Panel (1)



B. You can also go to the WP Dripper settings form using the Plugin List Panel.

1. File: This is where you select the Zip file containing the posts with you want to upload. The size of the Zip file has been limited to 2MB (2097152 bytes) which is the Maximum allowed size for uploaded files on most Host providers. There is no limit of number of files, as long as the total size of the Zip file is not larger than 2MB.

The files in the Zip file must be regular text files. The first non-empty line will be used as the title of the post. The rest of the file will be treated as content.

2. Start Time: This is where you set the start date and time for your posting. Note that this timestamp will NOT be the one of your first post. The first post will have a date and

3. time set that equals the start time + a random time between the minimum and maximum time interval (See 5)
4. Now: This button will (re-)set the timestamp to the current date and time.
5. Minimum: This is where you can set the minimum amount of time you want between two posts. The dropdown allows you to select the amount in minutes, hours, days and weeks.
6. Maximum: This is where you can set the maximum amount of time you want between two posts. You can select the amount in minutes, hours, days and weeks from the dropdown list.

The program will generate a timestamp between the minimum and maximum and add this to the timestamp of the start time (in case of the first post) or the previous post. You can set Minimum and Maximum equal to each other (this is how other autoposters work), but this would look very unnatural and could be penalized by the search engines.

7. Category: Select the desired category from the dropdown list for your posts.
8. Post Status: This will be the status of your posts. You can select "publish" , "Draft" or "Pending".
9. Comment Status: Select if you will allow comments on the posts you'll upload. Select "Open" to allow, "Closed" to disallow comments.
10. Auto Tags: You have the possibility to have WordPress tags created automatically for your post. When Auto Tags is selected, the program will automatically generate the relevant tags for the provided content by making use of the Yahoo term extraction api.

NOTE: Yahoo restricts the api usage for 5000 requests in 24 hours from a single IP. So, if your requests goes beyond that, you will get no tags returned.

Creating posts using the Auto tag option will cause the program to take a bit longer .If you are uploading many text files (>100) at the same time with the Auto tag option on, there is a chance that the program times out (Depending on environment, but timeout is usually set at 30 seconds).

11. Add Posts: This button will start the posts creation. When the posts have been created, an information message will be displayed at the top of the screen.
